## **DESTINATION SCHOOL RESULTS**

Thanks to those parents who filled in the PTA Feeder School Survey . The aim was to conduct research to identify preferred secondary school destinations.

The top 4 results for boys, girls and overall are below, based on responses received:

Newpark was a clear favourite, which is unsurprising given its proximity to Guardian Angels, however two things to note with regard to Newpark; it is a Protestant school and therefore its main obligations around admissions are to the Protestant community. While Guardian Angels is within 10km of Newpark, and therefore counted as being in the catchment area, note that there are 30 feeder schools (Protestant and Educate Together) listed ahead of this criteria.

From speaking with the school it was noted that in a typical year, the majority of applicants to Sion Hill and Oatlands College are admitted. A number of the boys' private schools, e.g. St Andrews, Blackrock etc. have junior schools attached and priority is given to those schools and, sometimes, a limited number of feeders. Note also that St. Andrews College is also Protestant and has a junior school.

The results were not ranked in order of preference so the above tables are based on the number of times each school was picked as a response.
